

# Alton U3A Ramblers.

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2025

6.5 mile walk from South Warnborough



START: Meet at 9.15 ready for a 9.30 start. Head for South Warnborough RG29 1RS, and park in the big layby. If you are coming into South Warnborough from Alton along the B3349, the entrance to the layby is the second on the LHS. (although you can also access it from the first left turn) This layby is called 'Alton Road' on streetview. If you miss this turn, turn left into it at the other end. There is plenty of free parking in this big layby. The turn off the B3349 is at What3words shine.remarried.processor Or SU719470.

Meet at the far (north) end of the layby for the start of the walk: the village end.

Please bring a drink and a snack for a 10-15 minute break during the walk. Wear suitable footwear and clothing for a spring walk: packable waterproofs may still be necessary. Please remember you walk at your own risk. We follow designated footpaths on tarmac and across/round fields and through woods. Generally good. Gentle inclines but no big hills. No stiles. We cross the Odiham road in South Warnborough and a local road. Also in Long Sutton. Some of the lanes are quite bendy – please follow the walk leader's advice as to the side with best visibility for traffic and keep well to the side of any road/lane.

We should be back by 12.45. Options for lunch or a coffee for those who require refreshment are a short walk up the road from the lay-by: the Post Office/Village shop has a café, with tables inside and outside, open until 3pm for light lunch of sandwiches baguettes etc, coffee, tea. Or, a little further but still only a very short walk, to the Poacher Inn which does midweek lunch and drink for £12
