- 9.45 am** Meet at entrance to Chapel Common OS grid ref SU 813286
What 3 Words honeybees.jacuzzi.expansion
Chapel Common is along B2070 between Rake and Liphook, about 30 mins from Alton.

Suggested route:

Leave Alton along the B3006 towards and through Selborne, continue towards the A3 but where the road turns sharp right, turn left towards Greatham and in a few hundred yards turn right towards Liss Forest. After 1.5 miles go over a level crossing, bear right and immediately take the first left into Wylde Green Lane. At a T junction turn right and take the first left into Hatch Lane and after almost a mile join the B2070, turning left, entering Rake. In $\frac{1}{2}$ mile pass Flying Bull pub on left, another $\frac{1}{2}$ mile pass car sales and Rake Primary School on left, turn left here and in a little less than $\frac{1}{2}$ mile turn right and park on side of this lane towards the end, near a gate onto Chapel Common. About 30 minutes from Alton.

- 10.00 am** Set off on a walk of around 6.5 miles across Chapel Common, then descending Maysleith Hanger and climbing Wardleys Hanger with views to the South Downs. One longish climb.

It is always important to carry water or other appropriate liquid refreshment, and a hand sanitiser is advisable

- 1.00 pm** Approx time of return to our starting point.
