UPPARK HOUSE



I'm sure you are all familiar with Uppark, the beautiful 17th century house sitting up on the South Downs, with its stunning interior, furniture and ornaments, and a cohort of colourful owners! The house is now open for booked tours after 18 months of closure for major works. Gardens are free if you want to explore after the walk. Or use the pop-up coffee van to sup and sit and enjoy the views after the walk. And a great bookshop too!

Starting point is the car park at Uppark House. Free to National Trust members. What3words baroness.user.trailing Post code: GU315QR. 5 miles SE of Petersfield on the B2146, through South Harting (traffic lights here), and then up the hill to the house.

Start and end time: Car park is open from 09.30. Be booted and ready to start walking at 09.45. Should be back by 12.30. Walk is 6 miles.

Stiles etc: stiles, kissing gates.

Terrain: open gravel paths, some scrubby paths, tarmac on quiet lanes, field edges and across fields. We cross the main road twice: care is required. Open views and points of interest along the way.

What to bring: yourself! Fit and well. For your comfort and enjoyment please bring water and/or flask and a snack for a brief refreshment stop. Wear appropriate footwear and clothing for a hike. Remember to bring your ICE number easily accessible in your bag/rucksack or on your phone. Dogs with well-behaved owners welcome.
