## Kew Gardens

Saturday 27 June 2026



Kew Gardens is famous for its diverse collection of plants, its status as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and its importance as a global centre for botanical science and conservation. It is home to the world's largest living plant collection, historic glass houses, the Great Pagoda, Kew Palace and the Treetop Walkway. This year it will also be presenting the largest ever outdoor exhibition of works by Henry Moore including 30 sculptures around the Gardens.

### **Pick Up Points**
