Supreme Court

The Supreme Court of the United Kingdom is the final court of appeal in the UK for civil cases, and criminal cases from England, Wales and Northern Ireland. It hears cases of the greatest public or constitutional importance affecting the whole population. This trip includes a private group tour for up to 30 members and includes information about the history of the Court and the building, the artworks on display and landmark cases in the Court's history. The tour will commence at 11am and last for approximately an hour.

Following the tour there will be free time in London for members to do as they please. The Court is in Parliament Square, Westminster. There are buses and a tube station nearby.

Cost and Pick Up Points

The cost of the coach and the tour is £20, and numbers are limited to 30. Bookings will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. There will be an additional 25 seats on the coach for members who do not wish to take the tour at a cost of £10. The coach will leave from Four Marks (Co-op) at 8.30 am and from Sainsbury's in Alton at 8.45 am. It will leave for the return journey at 4 pm.
